

BRIGHTWATER MAILBOX REMINDER

IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING BRIGHTWATER MAILBOXES

As our community ages, mailboxes are beginning to rust and are in need of repair. To maintain the uniformity of our neighborhood and to minimize cost, all residents should follow the guidelines set forth by the Brightwater HOA Board of Directors:

- **PAINT:**
PRIMER: Rustoleum rust reformer- mat black; and
COLOR: Rustoleum satin black smooth protective enamel
- Mailboxes should include the house number and the Brightwater logo on both sides of the circular tube.
- All mailboxes should display the Brightwater Logo.
- All residents should paint their mailboxes by **October 31**
- Violation letters issued in November to any homeowner who has not met the deadline to paint their mailbox and post.
