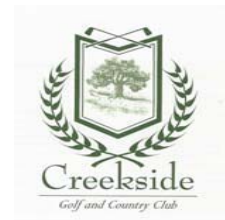


2011 CREEKSIDE POOL RULES

“No Lifeguard On Duty”

(Swim at your own risk)



1. The pool will be open daily from 6AM – 11PM
2. The pool is for homeowners and guests use only. Homeowners must accompany their guests at all times. Guests are limited to 4 per household. Homeowners & Guests must abide by all pool rules.
3. Homeowners, children, and guests must display their pool identification when using the pool. If identification cannot be presented, persons may be asked to leave the pool area.
4. Homeowners in a Delinquent status cannot use the pool facilities.
5. Children under the age of 13 will not be allowed in the pool area unless they are accompanied by someone 16 years of age or older. No children should be in the pool without adult supervision.
6. Each person should shower before entering the pool.
7. Proper swimming attire required (no “cut-offs” or street clothes).
8. Infants/children who are not toilet-trained and adults who are incontinent **MUST** wear swim diapers in the pool. Disposable diapers are **RESTRICTED** and violators will be asked to exit pool until proper swim diaper is in use. Diaper changing stations are available in the rest rooms & must be used for changing.
9. Radios, CD players, MP3 players, etc... are permitted at **LOW** volume. Earphones must be used if any resident finds the music disturbing or offensive.
10. No glass is allowed in pool or pool area
11. Running, diving, horseplay, foul/offensive language, and misuse of pool furniture / equipment / safety devices are strictly prohibited.
12. Spitting, spouting, and nose-blowing in the pool are prohibited.
13. Animals/pets, bikes, and skateboards are prohibited in the pool area.
14. No one under the influence of drugs or alcohol should use the pool.
15. No one with illness and/or nausea and open cuts or wounds should enter the pool.
16. Anyone caught contaminating pool (i.e. defecating, vomiting, urinating, etc...) will be held accountable and fines may be assessed at \$250 per offense to responsible party.
17. Homeowners and guest are expected to clean up pool area after themselves (i.e. drinks, food items dropped on ground, trash, toys etc.)
18. While Lifeguard is on duty; all rules will be enforced and disciplinary actions taken if not followed.
19. No one should engage the lifeguard in unnecessary conversation. Please refrain from distracting the lifeguards while they are on duty – they are here for your safety.

Phone for Emergency Use only - NO PERSONAL CALLS
First Aid Kit located on wall near bathrooms.

DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES- Lifeguards have full authority of the pool while on duty. When necessary the following disciplinary procedures will be followed:

Non Violent Offenses- 1st offense: Verbal warning, 2nd: 15 minutes out of pool, 3rd: 1 hour out of pool, 4th: 1 day ejection from pool and pool committee/Board of Directors referred for further action.

Violent Offenses- 1st offense: 1 full day out of pool, 2nd: 1 full week out of pool, 3rd: Indefinite ejection from pool. Swim committee/board of directors referred for all violent offenses for further action. Homeowner will receive written notice of all violent and 4th non violent offenses with details and further action taken by Board of Directors.

Poolside News – NOT SMOKING

The Pool Rules have been updated since last season. One big change, voted on by homeowners during last pool season, is the new NO SMOKING rule. Smoking is no longer permitted anywhere inside the amenities area (Pool, Tennis, Pavilion and Playgrounds) or within 20 feet of the gates and fencing surrounding these areas. A smoking area has been established to the left hand side of parking lot, grassy area with bench. Please take time to review the pool rules with your family.

Important Pool Reminders to ALL Homeowners

- Homeowners must have their pool keycard present to enter AND while in the pool area. Entry to the pool by any other means other than through the main gate with your own keycard is NOT ALLOWED. ALL persons who enter the pool area by other means than a keycard at the gates AND all persons found to be using the pool that are not Creekside homeowners or guest of homeowners will be asked to leave the facility.
- Homeowners are permitted to have up to 4 guests at the pool. It has been noted on several occasions by other homeowners that this rule is being abused. Again, please... Maximum of 4 guests!
- Children that are not potty trained are REQUIRED to wear SWIM DIAPERS and/or swim pants at all times in pool. Regular disposable diapers ARE NOT ALLOWED. Violators will be asked to leave the facility.
- If a contamination (defecation, vomit, urination) of the pool area occurs the fine for this offense is \$250. This is a pool rule and all rules can be viewed by clicking on the link at the top of this page.
- Children ages 13 and under are not permitted to come to the pool without someone 16 years or older with them. This is a pool rule and for their safety.
- Only residents that are current with their dues are allowed to use the pool/tennis amenities area.

- The pool area and restrooms are for everyone's enjoyment. Please respect your neighbors by picking up after yourself on the pool deck and in the restrooms. Please look around before you leave and pick up any trash, toys, towels, etc., that may be forgotten. Also if you move furniture around and/or use umbrellas... PLEASE return them to their proper location before you leave. The bathrooms tend to get pretty 'trashed' also, so please help out here by not sending children unattended to bathrooms and clean up any mess that you make in this area.

We need help from all homeowners to keep the pool an enjoyable place for everyone. If you observe rule violations by other homeowners, do not hesitate to speak up. If a lifeguard is on duty, please ask him/her to intervene. If a lifeguard is not present, it is up to you to either intervene yourself OR if the situation warrants you can call 911 from your cell or the telephone installed on the pool house wall; then tell the Sheriff's Office about your situation at the Creekside Pool on Westchester Club Drive (off Dallas Nebo & Nebo Roads). All situations should be dealt with immediately.
