Using Your Recreation Area

Welcome to SweetPine Creek. We have put this information together for you so that you can utilize your facilities at the recreation area to the fullest. Please let your entire family read this.

PAVILIAN & POOL

Please call Pete Thompson for reserving the pavilion.

Holidays are reserved for the entire membership.

Please don't drive across the bridge unless you are loading or unloading food, equipment, or handicap persons. Please don't pull a vehicle under the Pavilion.

The phone next to the men's restroom is for your convenience. It is an extension to the builders' business line that is installed in the sales office. When you pick it up please listen for a dial tone before dialing, there may be a builder using it. Please keep your calls brief. Please do not let children play on this phone.

Please be sure to lock everything and turn off all lights if you are the last to leave.

BE SURE TO LOCK THE POOL GATE!!!

CLEAN UP AFTER USING FACILITIES

After using the facilities with your family, tennis group or any other functions, please inspect **all areas for trash and cleanliness including the creek, the tree house and the restrooms**. Please remove all trash bags, even if they aren't full, and replace with new bags. Please place all soiled diapers in a small plastic bag found in the restrooms, seal the bag and put it in the large rollaway trashcans in the parking lot. Replacement trash bags are found under the kitchen counter and under the sink in the restroom. On the large trash cans use the giant rubber bands to hold the trash bags in place. Your cooperation will insure that our Recreation Area is always presentable to members and your guest.

Pavilion Kitchen

Please call Pete Thompson for reserving the pavilion.

Children are not allowed in the kitchen area without adult supervision. The LP gas grills could be very dangerous. To use the grills you must turn the gas on at the small tanks that are inside the pool fence visible from the grills. There are some directions for the grills that have been laminated and placed next to the grills. Please read over these directions before using the grills. There are extra LP tanks behind the pump house.

Directions for Lighting Grills

- Before lighting a grill, check the grill gas valves to be sure they are **both** off.
- Open **both** grill covers,
- Turn on gas at the tank first, then turn on the gas at the grill you are lighting.
- Light the grill **by gently turning the lighter knob one quarter turn until it clicks.**
- **Be sure to open both grill tops before turning on the gas and lighting. If the grill does not light turn off gas and wait five minutes before trying again.**
- After grilling your food please turn the grill on high for 10 minutes to burn off the grease.

Please do not use abrasives to clean the enamel grill cover, use oven cleaner found under the kitchen sink. A water faucet and hose are under the sink area and next to the big green electric box. Please use the hose to clean up any spills. Please leave the cooking area cleaner than when you found it. There are cleaning supplies under the bathroom sinks, please use them if the need arises. To prevent smell and insects please remove all trash bags, even if they aren't full, and replace with new bags after hosting a group at the pavilion. Replacement trash bags are found under the kitchen counter or in the restrooms.

Please do not pour out water and salt from ice cream makers into the landscape it will kill grass and shrubs.

POOL

The combination for the lock is **8297**

Please do not allow children under the age of 13 to be in the pool area or in the pump room when not supervised by an adult.

The diving board could be hazardous if we do not supervise our children. Please allow only one person on the board at a time. Be sure that the area is completely clear before going off the board. **Dive at your own risk.**

Please replace the furniture to its original location when you are finished using it. Please wash off any food or drink that may spill on the furniture or pool deck so we don't have problems with insects. Because we have limited pool deck space please be aware of the space that you are taking. Be sure to leave room for people to walk past.

TENNIS COURTS

A tennis sign up sheet for reserving a court is in the cabinet near the restrooms. The combination locks found on the Tennis courts are the same as the pool **8297**. Just line up the numbers and push in the lock and it should pop open. To lock it just spin the numbers and close. The light switch is on the right side of the gate. The lights will not come back on for one half-hour after they are turned off. Tennis is the only activity allowed on the tennis courts. No bikes, roller blades, or scooters. Please do not allow children to play unsupervised on the courts. Discard all trash, (ball cans and tops, old balls), in the trashcan.

Your Recreation Area belongs to you and your neighbors. It should be treated as if it were in your back yard. If you see careless, unsafe or disrespectful behavior you should quietly and politely ask that the behavior stop.
